Classes

- BC1 Celebration Cake
- BC2 Chocolate Cake, filling & decoration optional
- BC3 Vintage Bake. A tea time bake from the 50's or 60's
- BC4 My Favourite Cake, filling & decoration optional
- BC5 4 Pieces of Traybake - cooked or uncooked
- BC6 Men only - Cake baked by a man, any flavour, filling & decoration optional

Junior Classes

(age 16 years and under on 2 June 2019, age to be stated on exhibit)

- BC7 4 Pieces of Traybake - cooked or uncooked
- BC8 4 Cupcakes – decorated
- BC9 2 Gingerbread People – decoration optional

Entry Fees*:

- Adult: £5 for first entry, £1 subsequent entries if pre-entered
- Children: £1 for first entry, 50p subsequent entries if pre-entered
- On the Day: Adult: £7, Junior: £2

Competition Rules

1. Cakes can be any size or shape.
2. To be judged on taste and appearance.
3. Entries to be brought to Country Fest on Saturday 1 June, to be displayed between 9.00am and 10.30am.
4. Pre-entries must be made before 12noon Thursday 30 May.
5. Judging to commence 10.45am.
6. Cakes to remain until Sunday 2 June when they can be collected after 3.30pm.
7. Categories may be split depending on entries.
8. Prizes presented at 3.00pm on Sunday 2 June.
9. Entry fees include admission to both days of Country Fest for the exhibitor – wristband to be collected on submission of exhibit Saturday 1 June.
10. An exhibitor may make as many entries as they wish; one weekend wristband issued per exhibitor.
